AN ORDINANCE CREATING A TRUST FUND FOR PHILHEALTH KONSULTASYONG SULIT AT TAMA (KONSULTA) FROM THE PROCEEDS OF THE PHILHEALTH KONSULTA BENEFIT PACKAGE TO BE PROVIDED BY THE PHILIPPINE HEALTH INSURANCE CORPORATION (PHILHEALTH) FOR QUALIFIED INDIGENT MEMBERS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PIÑAN UNDER THE INDIGENT COMPONENT SECTOR OF THE NATIONAL HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM (NHIP)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Piñan, Zamboanga del Norte in a session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title - This Municipal Ordinance shall be entitled "An Ordinance Creating a Trust Fund for PHILHEALTH Konsultasyong Sulit at Tama (KONSULTA) from the proceeds of the PhilHealth KONSULTA Benefit Package to be provided by the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHILHEALTH) for qualified indigent members of the municipality of Piñan under the Indigent Component Sector of the National Health Insurance Program (NHIP)".

Section 2. Objectives – The Local Government Unit of Piñan hereby adopts an integrated and comprehensive approach to health development which shall endeavor to

make essential goods, health and other social services available to all people at affordable cost. Under the Universal Health Care Act (UHC Act) and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) mandates the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) to develop a comprehensive outpatient benefit package that includes outpatient drug benefit and coverage for emergency medical services (*Sec. 6 (b), Republic Act No. 11223 and Sec. 6.3 of its IRR*). Thus, PhilHealth issues Governing Policies of the Konsulta+ (PhilHealth Circular (PC) No. 2022-0032) outlining concepts and mechanisms for the comprehensive outpatient benefit.

PhilHealth Board Resolution (PBR) No. 2795, Series of 2023 advances the current system and the providers towards Konsulta+ adding from the existing primary care package to integrate benefit packages related to Tuberculosis, outpatient HIV/AIDS, Malaria, and Animal Bite.

This approach is related to the attainment of the country's commitment to reaching the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) related targets.

Section 3. Use, Management and Disposition of the Fund. The use, management and disposition of the PhilHealth Konsulta Benefit Package shall be governed by the following rules:

1. The disposition of the PhilHealth Konsulta shall be governed by the following rules:
 - a. Seventy percent (70%) of the PhilHealth Konsulta Benefit Package is for operational cost and shall be divided, as follows:
 - a. Minimum of Seventy percent (70%) for all essential services, medicines provided for in this PhilHealth Circular and other operating expenses to support delivery of health care including but not limited to engagement of additional personnel (*e.g. physician, dentist, nurses, pharmacist, midwives, etc.; and also non-healthcare workers such as encoders, among others*), internet subscription, IT service provider subscription fee and hardware.
 - b. Maximum of Thirty percent (30%) for reagents, medical supplies, equipment, capacity building for staff, infrastructure or any other use related, necessary for the delivery of required service including referral fees for diagnostics services if not available in the facility.
 - b. The remaining Thirty percent (30%) shall be exclusively utilized as Performance Incentives for Health Workers and Non-Health professionals/staff in the following manner:
 - b.1. Ten Percent (10%) for the physician;
 - b.2. Fifteen percent (15%) for other health professional staff of the facility; and
 - b.3. Five percent (5%) for non-health professionals/ staff including volunteers and community members of health teams.
 - c. A separate book of account shall be maintained by the local government unit; and

d. The PhilHealth Konsulta shall be used only for the specified purposes stipulated in the PhilHealth Konsulta Benefit Package (*PhilHealth Circular No. 2023-0013*) Guidelines.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof, which are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE – All Ordinances, rules or regulations in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed; *PROVIDED*, that the rights already vested under those ordinances, rules and regulations shall not be impaired.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY – This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval by the reviewing authority.
